Choose from the following classes:

Engineering Snap Circuits – Build circuits and experiment with motors, switches, resistors, capacitors, transistors, etc.

Tech Exploration – Students will explore technology through a variety of hands-on activities including the use of a plasma cutter to cut vinyl graphics they design.

Engineering – Explore different engineering activities, such as learning about projectile motion, hydraulic power, wind energy, aerospace, and electrical energy.

Computer Networking & Security – Learn the skills of computer networking, system administration, and computer security through a series of fun and exciting hands-on activities.

Carpentry – Students will learn the basics of carpentry and create their own hands-on project.

Video & Moviemaking – Students will create their own videos and movies.

Game Design – Students will learn the basics of video game design.

Anatomy & Physiology – Hands-on learning and exploration of understanding how the human body works.

Photography-BYOC – Say “cheese!” Students must provide their own digital camera. Give it your best shot! This class is only offered June 4 through 8.

Teacher Prep – Learn what it takes to be a great teacher! Students will also be trained in CPR. For an additional \$14.00, student will receive a CPR card and book.
